### **Market Insight**

## • FERRO-SILICON: European suppliers hold for more quarterly deals; US market stagnant

The European ferro-silicon market was unchanged despite a lower fourth-quarter deal being done in the week ended Friday October 4 because suppliers are waiting for further quarterly deals for delivery up to January before making any decision on their offer prices for prompt shipment.

European suppliers hold offer prices. European demand slower than usual, more Q4 business expected. US market maintains range, still awaiting end of year business. European market pauses, awaits new business. In Europe, the spot market has been steady in the past week after dropping to a low last seen in August 2016 the week before. Suppliers have held their offer prices and will wait for further developments in the longer-term delivery market for contract business shipped between October and December. One quarterly deal for around 500 tonnes of standard grade ferro-silicon was settled to a German steelmaker for €885 per tonne delivered, sources said. Fastmarkets assessed the price of ferro-silicon, lumpy, basis 75% Si (scale pro rata), delivered Europe at €900-920 (\$988-1,010) per tonne on Friday, steady week on week. The last time the European spot ferro-silicon price was below €900 per tonne was in April 2016...

#### • Silicon price slump drives Ferroglobe to extend outages

Ferroglobe Plc plans to reduce silicon metal and alloy production by extending or bringing forward several planned outages during the fourth quarter, the company announced on Friday October 4.

The leading global silicon metal producer, which faces falling silicon prices, did not specify the tonnages involved in the latest cuts, which include: In France, three silicon furnaces will be idled on October 7, two in Montricher and one in Laudun. Two French furnaces producing ferro-silicon in Chateau-Feuillet were idled on September 30, 2019, and a third - in Laudun - will be idled on November 15. The silicon plant in

Polokwane, South Africa, has been idled since August 1. Silicon production has been reduced at the plant in Sabon, Spain. In North America, Canada's Bécancour, Québec, joint-venture facility producing silicon metal also idled its No4 furnace...

#### • Vale expects additional 50mln tpy of pellet demand from China until 2025

Vale expects Chinese demand for iron ore pellets and pellet feed to rise by 50 million tonnes per year with mills in China increasing the usage of pellets in their blast furnaces.

It estimates that pellet consumption could increase its proportion of the total raw material mix in blast furnaces from 11% in 2015 to 19% in 2025, according to a presentation that the Brazilian miner showed to investors and analysts last week. The miner expects to supply the seaborne market with 30 million tpy of a new type of pellet feed from its Carajás unit, in the Brazilian northern state of Pará, in "the medium term," it added. This scenario arises from the Chinese government's drive to curb pollution in the country's main cities, Vale said....

#### • China's CRC, HDG export prices stable at end of Golden Week holiday

Export prices for Chinese cold-rolled coil and hot-dipped galvanized coil were unchanged during the week to Tuesday October 8 due to Golden Week - the week-long holiday to mark the country's 70th anniversary.

Cold rolled coil Fastmarkets' weekly price assessment for steel cold-rolled coil (CRC), export, fob China, was \$500-505 per tonne on Tuesday October 8, unchanged from September 24.

## **International Data**

#### • Ferrosilicon Exports in August and from January to August

According to data from China Customs, for the month of August, 2019, China exported a total of 23038.369 tons of ferrosilicon (>55%), down by around 9.88% vs. the July, down by 51.95% vs. the same period in 2018.

In August, China exported 7596 tons of ferrosilicon (>55%) to Korea, about 32.97% of the total exports in August, and exported 5284.05 tons to Japan, about 22.94% of the total exports in August.


For the first eight months of 2019, China exported 266745.693 tons of ferrosilicon (>55%) in total, down by 28.23% vs. the same period in 2018. Including 86505.457 tons to Japan, about 32.43% of the total exports from January to August, and 62943.1 tons to Korea, accounts for around 23.6%.

For the month of August, China exported a total of 2203.023 tons of ferrosilicon (≤ 55%), up by 16.7% than July and down by 13.08% than the same period in 2018.

In August, China exported 638 tons of ferrosilicon ( $\leq$ 55%) to Korea, about 28.96% of the total exports in August, and exported 499 tons to Japan, about 22.65%.

For the first eight months of 2019, China exported 20989.859 tons of ferrosilicon ( $\leq$  55%), up by about 10.39% than the same period in 2018.

From January to August, China exported 7027.05 tons of ferrosilicon ( $\leq$ 55%) to Korea, about 33.48% of the total exports in the first months, and exported 4671.175 tons to Japan, about 22.25% of the total exports in the first months.



#### • Korea imported 22728.43 tons of ferrosilicon (>55%) in August

According to data of Korea Customs, Korea imported 22728.43 tons of ferrosilicon (>55%) for the month of August, up by 5.44% than the same period in 2018, including 13892 tons imported from China, about 61.12% of its total imports in

For the month of August, Japan imported 2578 tons of ferrosilicon ( $\leq$ 55%), up by around 183.84% vs. July and up by 133.14% vs. the same period in 2018.

For the first eight months of 2019, Japan imported 13285.212 tons of ferrosilicon (≤ 55%), up by 22.41% vs. the same period in 2018.

#### • The World Steel Association: August 2019 crude steel production

World crude steel production for the 64 countries reporting to the World Steel Association (worldsteel) was 156.0 million tonnes (Mt) in August 2019, a 3.4% increase compared to August 2018.

China's crude steel production for August 2019 was 87.3 Mt, an increase of 9.3% compared to August 2018. Japan produced 8.1 Mt of crude steel in August 2019, down 7.8% on August 2018. South Korea's crude steel production was 5.9 Mt in August 2019, a decrease of 2.6% on August 2018.


In the EU, Germany produced 3.3 Mt of crude steel in August 2019, up by 0.8% on August 2018. Italy produced 0.9 Mt of crude steel in August 2019, down by 26.7% on August 2018. France produced 1.1 Mt of crude steel in August 2019, an increase of 11.2% compared to August 2018. Spain produced 1.1 Mt of crude steel in August 2019, down by 4.6% on August 2018.

The US produced 7.5 Mt of crude steel in August 2019, an increase of 0.3% compared to August 2018.

Brazil's crude steel production for August 2019 was 2.5 Mt, down by 13.4% on August 2018.

Turkey's crude steel production for August 2019 was 2.6 Mt, down by 12.4% on August 2018.

Crude steel production in Ukraine was 1.9 Mt this month, up 8.5% on August 2018.
